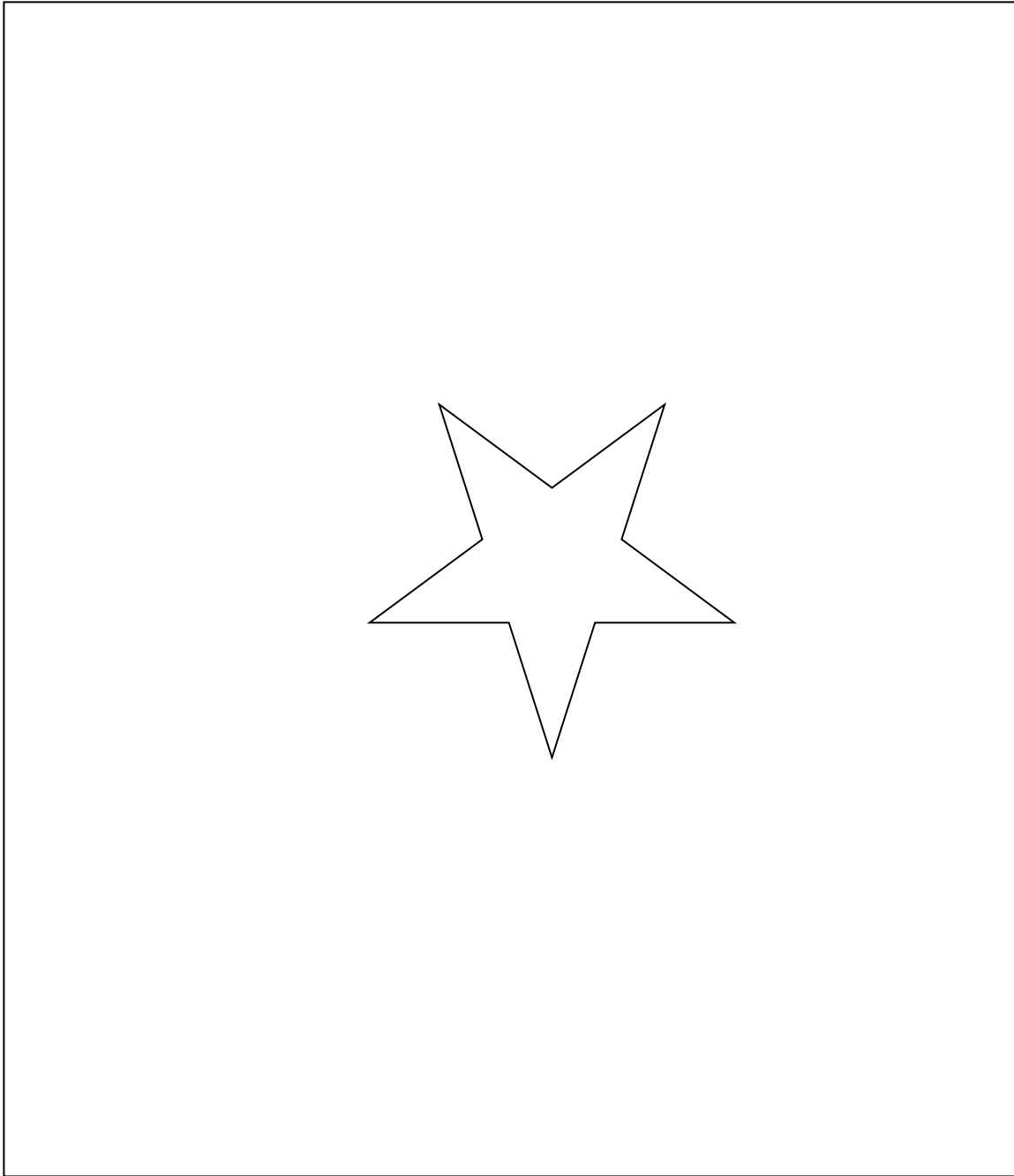

**EAST**

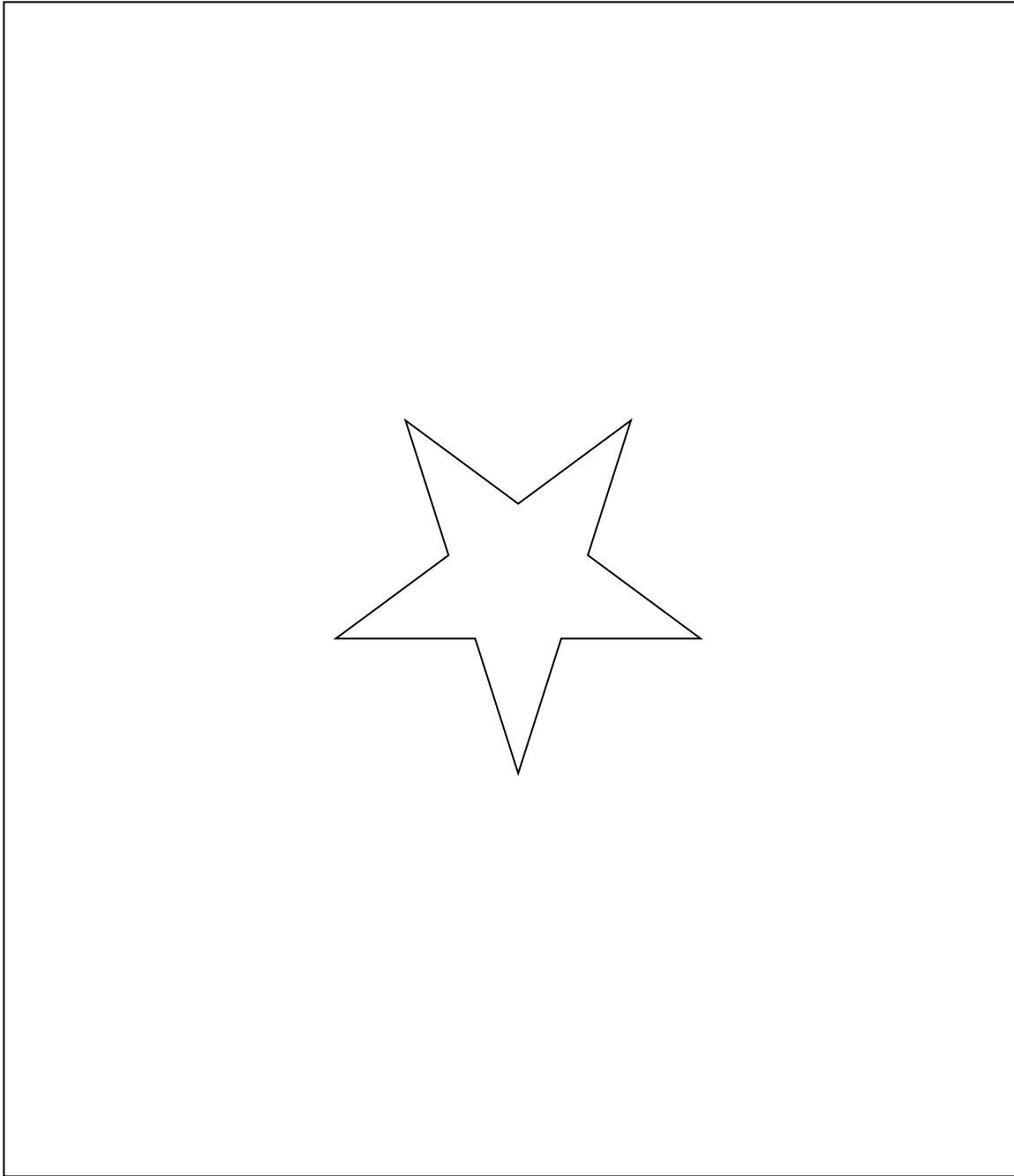


**WEST**
